

The Isle of Man Victorian Society was formed in 1976 on the lines of the Victorian Society in the United Kingdom. It aims to preserve the best of Manx Victorian and Edwardian architecture, and also to inform, encourage and promote study of the arts, crafts and history of the period.

It is particularly concerned to protect important Manx nineteenth and early twentieth century buildings, both public and private, industrial monuments and historical areas.

The Isle of Man Victorian Society generally meets on a monthly basis during the winter months at The Barbara Cottier Lecture Theatre, St. Ninian's High School, Douglas, and in the summer it organises visits to buildings or areas of Victorian and Edwardian interest.

A knowledge of the Victorian period is not necessary! The object of each meeting is to enlighten and to awaken the interest of members to the heritage present on everyone's doorstep. Everyone receives a warm welcome.

Prospective members and visitors are welcome to attend – a small admission charge covers room hire.

The membership fee is £10.00 per annum; family membership (all members of a family at the same address) is £15.00.
